A brief signing ceremony marked the agreement on Friday, 2nd July 2021, at the University's Council Chamber.

He revealed that the project had gone through several stages of rigorous evaluation, both from internal and external assessments and thus, assured the gathering of value for money.

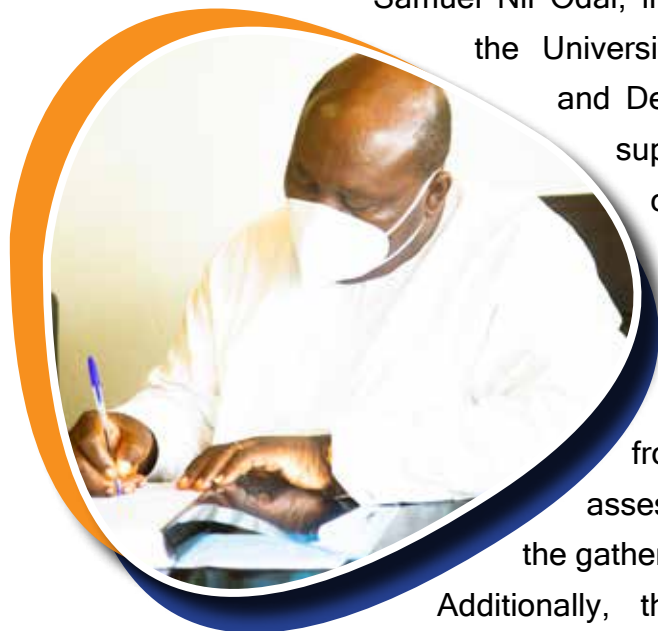
Additionally, the Vice-Chancellor urged
