PREFACE

ATU is committed to the development and reputation of academic staff through quality research outputs as exhibited in this Research Publications Bulletin Volume 2, 2023. This Research Publications Bulletin contains the publications of academic staff in high impact refereed journals and conference proceedings indexed by Web of Science and Scopus in all our five (5) Faculties and sixteen (16) Academic Departments in ATU.

Specifically focusing on Pillar 2 (Impact-Oriented Research) in our Strategic Plan (2021-2025), DRIPTT drives the research agenda of ATU, as stated by the Vice-Chancellor. This will guarantee high standards for research in our institution, which will eventually raise ATU's standing on national and international scales.

DRIPTT under the Office of the Vice-Chancellor's is committed to ensure quality of publications, which is in line with Pillar 2 of our Strategic Plan (2021-2025). In summary, a total of 55 articles/papers have been published by 28 out of 248 full time academic staff in the year 2022, representing a staff to publication ratio of 0.11 (11%). The total number of publications by academic staff has improved in comparison to 50 in 2021. In recognition of the extensive difficulties in publishing in web of science and scopus, the 28 academic staff as shown in this research bulletin, have done extremely well and made ATU tremendously proud. Additionally, at the closure of 2022, 83 out of 248 full time academic staff (33%) in comparison 18% in 2021 are currently registered on Google Scholar. DRIPTT will continue to liaise with HODs and Deans to improve this situation by further facilitating research publications and visibility agenda in ATU.

It is important to note that this Research Publications Bulletin Volume 2, 2023 contains a thorough overview of the academic staff in each academic department and faculty, as well as information about their publication trends in high impact publication outlets for the calendar year 2022. We sincerely thank all academic departments and faculty members for the submission of their research outputs in order for the second edition of the Research Publications Bulletin to be developed and published.
















STAFF PUBLICATION RATIO OF FACULTIES IN 2022


